Placing the Impossible in God's Hands Sunday March 22, 2020 | Mark 6:30-44

After the disciples' first mission trip, they sat down to debrief with Jesus. Tired, exhausted, and at their limits, Jesus took them on a retreat to a desolate area. Once there, a large crowd greeted them on the shore. The test for the disciples had started. Instead of running from the crowd, Jesus saw it as a ministry opportunity. The miracle of feeding the five thousand revealed that Jesus is the Great Provider. The miracle was also to benefit the disciples' faith.
